The Sound of G

Make the /g/ Sound

Place your hand on your throat. Say 'g-g-g'.

It sounds like water going down your throat: *gulp, gulp, gulp!*

Can you feel your throat move?

How to Write Gg

Big G

Make a big round 'C', then give it a little shelf to sit on.



Small g

Draw a circle, then give it a hook that hangs down low.



Our Magic G Words



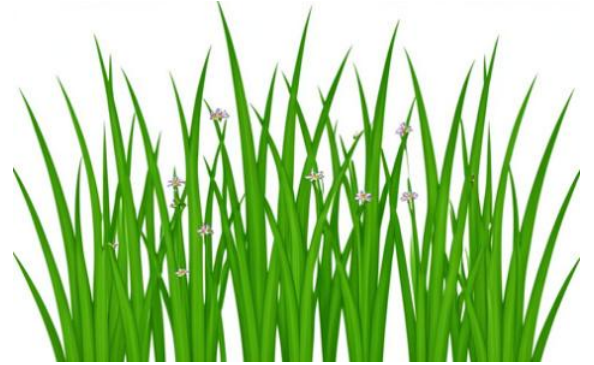
Gift
