Meet Big V and Little v

The uppercase **V** and lowercase **v** look almost exactly the same! One is just a little bit taller than the other.

Remember

V has two straight lines that meet at the bottom in a sharp point.





Can you feel the buzz?

Put your top teeth on your bottom lip. Now, make a humming sound! Does it tickle? That's the sound of the letter V!

The letter V sounds like a tiny airplane motor! Vvvvrum!

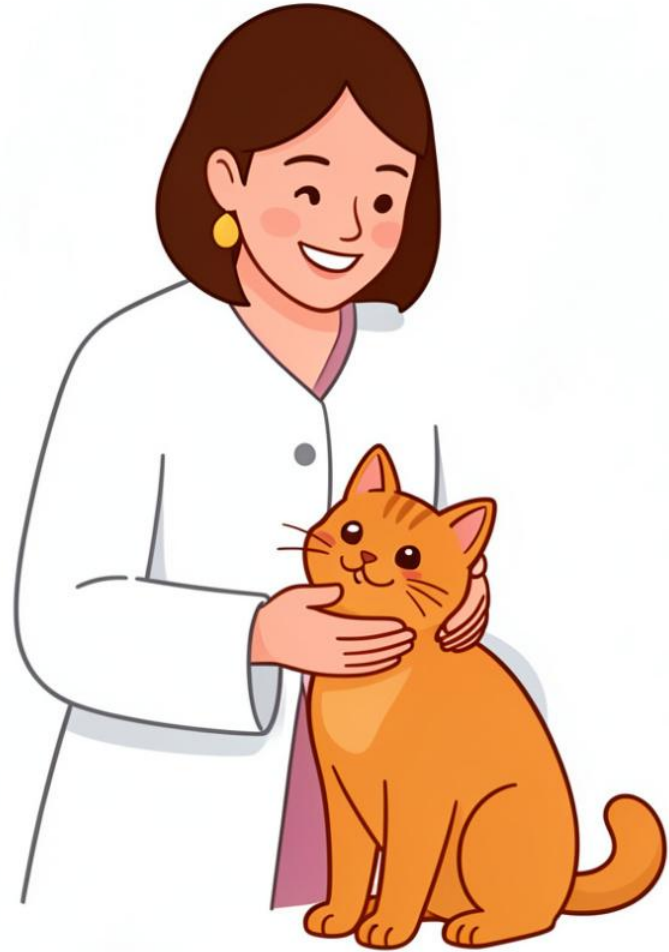
V is for Van
